# Can I build a tennis court in my backyard?

### Will it fit?

The ideal backyard or domestic tennis courts size is 33.5m x 16.2m and it's recommended to build a court no smaller than 30 metres by 15 metres. It is also best to design your tennis court layout with your other outdoor areas taken into consideration, eg pools, outdoor entertaining, and views.

# What permissions do you need?

You may need to apply for a development application, DA from your local council. If your property is rural, you may be applicable for an exempt development application. The SSG team can help you with any questions and further details for your submission.

## What Tennis Court Surface can I have?

The surface chosen usually depends on cost/ budget and playing surface preference.

- Acrylic Painted Hard Court Excellent bounce and very low maintenance
- Synthetic Grass Most popular surface chosen and offers consistent playability and compfort.

### What will it cost?

Full construction of Acrylic Painted hard Court

• From \$90,000 on a concrete base

Full construction Synthetic Grass tennis court

• From \$90,000 on a stabilized base

Things that will affect your budget include;

- Size
- Where your court is being built, what it is being built on,
- Addition extras and accessories like lighting and equipment.

### How long will it take?

The time it takes to build a tennis court will vary on the scope of works required.

Generally for a standard construction of a tennis court should take 4-6 weeks. This excludes any initial design requirements if required
